In an Emergency, dial 999. A Defibrillator situated on village green.

Report all injuries, accidents and incidents, perceived or otherwise, in the Incidents & Accident Book. These are events that have, or may have, resulted in an injury, sustained during Club activities or whilst on Club premises.

The Trustees will regularly review the accident and incident reports. All reports must be forwarded to the Trustees for action and review.

The Trustees will regularly review and monitor implementation of this policy.

Club members have a duty to:

Take reasonable care for their own health & safety and that of others who may be affected by anything they do, or do not do.

Co-operate with the Club on health & safety issues.

Correctly use any equipment provided by the Club. Not interfere with, nor misuse, any items provided by the Club for health & safety purposes.
